Illinoisans Advocating for Kids.

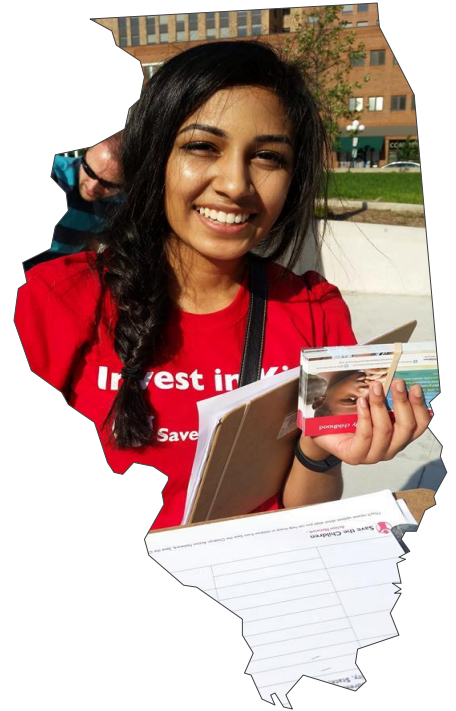
